The 2025 Rallye des Iles du Soleil will start from **Marina Lanzarote** in the Canary Islands.

After the first stage, a stopover of a few days will take place in the famous

bay of Mindelo, in Cape Verde.

Finally, it is on the authentic island of **Marie-Galante** and its magnificent bay of Saint-Louis that the Rally will arrive for its seventh edition.

#### Requirements

The Rally is open to all sailboats over 10 meters, category A, with at least 2 people on board.

It is necessary to have specific safety and communication equipment on board (see equipment), a regulatory pharmacy as well as a World Sailing Offshore Personal Survival courses for the person in charge or co-skipper.

#### Refunds

In accordance with regulations in force, participants have fourteen days, from the date of submitting the registration form, to exercise their right of withdrawal without having to justify a reason or pay any penalties other than return costs.

If you register and decide that you will not be able to participate in the Rally, it is possible to choose a refund, or transfer the deposit to the following year.






### 1ENSPECIFIC

We want to provide a safe We require that all Rally boats environment for participants and provide them with the information they need to make decisions safely for their boat and their crew.

carry a defined list of safety and communications equipment and that skippers or co-skippers have completed safety/survival training.

Before the start of the Rally, each boat will have to undergo a "safety inspection" during which the various regulatory points will be checked and discussions will be held with the skipper and crew on their approaches to offshore navigation and safety.



#### **SAFETY**

The safety equipment required to participate in the *Rallye des lles du Soleil* has been designed to ensure the safety of all participants.

It is based on division 240 which defines "weapons and security equipment and limits of use" and on the experience of the cruise director and his teams. Among other things: An ISO 9650 liferaft that contain a minimum Pack 1 (greater than 24 hour pack), an EPIRB, a ManOverBoard pole, a Main sail with at least 2 reefs, a PLB unit...

#### **COMMUNICATION**

Each vessel shall be equipped with at least, among others, an equipment capable of receiving and sending emails at sea, a class B AIS transponder, a GPS capable of recording a crew overboard position,

### CREW & TRAINING

It is mandatory to be, at the very least, 2 adults present per boat. At least one member of the crew (person or second in charge) shall have undertaken a World Sailing Offshore Personnal Survival training.

When there are only two crewmembers, both shall have undertaken the World Sailing Offshore Personnal Survival training course.

All the crew members, whether French or foreign, must hold a «competition» licence issued by the French Sailing Federation "FFVoile" valid for the entire period of the Rally.

#### MEDICAL

Each boat must have on board a regulatory pharmacy, checked by the referring doctor in La Palma. Each crew member will have to complete a medical form and transfer their file to the referring doctor.
